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Presentation

For its seventh season, the Series Mania Festival is taking things up to the next level in the light of the growing popularity of TV series and the formidable growth of this professional sector on an international scale.

The Series Mania Festival was created by the Forum des images, and will be **even** bigger this year, both in terms of its programming and the number of participants it expects to welcome. Last year, 22,000 members of the public and 980 professionals attended the event.

This 2016 edition focuses on audacity and innovation, offering all participants – from the merely curious to confirmed TV addicts, along with key industry players – a unique showcase of international small-screen creativity magnified onto the big screen. It promises 10 exhilarating days including some brand new temptations mixed with tried-and-tested, carefully crafted favorites, with excitement guaranteed!

The International Competition and jury

This year for the first time, Series Mania is organizing an international competition of world premieres. It will include **eight ambitious projects** that will enjoy premiere screenings either before or just after they have been shown in their home territory. Entries hail from Argentina, Australia, Belgium, France, Israel, Norway, Sweden, and the UK, demonstrating the confidence the industry has in the international scope of Series Mania.

The competition also offers a snapshot of what's hot in the industry right now, from taking a fresh look at an old genre such as thriller with *The Five*; creating new forms, with *Beau séjour* and *The Kettering Incident*; raising questions about modern society, with *Mama's Angel* or *Nobel*; offering a realistic interpretation of unknown worlds with *El Marginal* and *Cannabis*; and from an industry perspective, revealing the dynamism of European coproductions with *Midnight Sun*.

Series Mania will be presenting these daring new productions to an international jury headed by celebrated showrunner **David Chase**. As the creator of cult series *The Sopranos*, Chase is the perfect person to oversee **the first jury**, which will include four other big names from the world of series, cinema, and culture.

A cross-section of international TV series

In addition to this unique competition, Series Mania will be confirming its programming strategy with a world tour of TV series through more than 50 premieres drawn from the very best of French, American, and international productions, along with the Webseries sidebar.

The different sections illustrate **current trends and emerging new styles.** Female creators and directors will be very much in evidence, particularly in terms of comedy, but in other genres, too. They include Swedish writer Cilla Börjlind (*Spring Tide*), American actress, writer, producer, and director Amy Seimetz, along with Lodge Kerrigan (*Girlfriend Experience*), and Brit writer Marnie Dickens (*Thirteen*).

American productions will bear witness to the growing presence of web distribution platforms such as Hulu, Amazon, and Netflix.

Belgian series, in particular from French-speaking Belgium, will be returning with brio (*Ennemi public*, *La Trève*), along with the highly anticipated *Au-delà des murs* from France.

Latin America has made a remarkable breakthrough in **the Panorama** with *Cromo*; northern Europe is maintaining its expertise in terms of the thriller genre (*Bordertown*, *The Pact*); and Australia continues its penchant for social critique (*Cleverman*).

The UK also brings several very successful adaptations of works by authors including John Le Carré (*The Night Manager*) and Tolstoy (*War and Peace*).

The 16 shows in the Webseries selection demonstrate unrivalled creativity. They include output from France (*Le Ball Trap*), Canada (*L'Écrivain public*), Germany (*Transatlantics*), but also Asian production, notably from India (*Bang Baaja Baaraat*) and South Korea (*Lily Fever*).

With the creation this year of a **prize from the Association des Critiques de Series** for the American section, each part of the Festival will be judged by its own jury. The International Press Jury will judge French series, the Bloggers' Jury will evaluate the Panorama, and the online audience gets to vote for best webseries. These prizes, along with those from the International Competition and the Audience Award will be presented during the closing ceremony.

Backstage

Series Mania prides itself on being a place where fest-goers can meet up with the creators, directors, writers, actors, and producers who come to the event to share their experiences. **More than 30 guests** are expected at this year's event to talk to audiences after screenings or within the framework of special sessions.

Among the highpoints of this year's Series Mania festival, **David Chase** will be giving a masterclass on *The Sopranos*, his most celebrated work.

Cuba Gooding Junior will be exploring the character of O.J Simpson that he plays in one of the America's current hit shows (*The People v. O.J. Simpson : American Crime Story*).

Showrunner **Clyde Phillips** (*Dexter*) will be there for the world premier screening of his latest series, *Feed the Beast*.

Internationally celebrated author **Harlan Coben** (*The Five*) will be at Series Mania to discuss how he adapts his work for the small screen.

Frank Spotnitz (*The Man in The High Castle*) and **Stephen Poliakoff** (*Close to the Enemy*) will also be joining the ranks of the talented creators attending the festival.

Several key women in the industry will be attending the festival. In particular, **Leila Bekhti**, star of the Nordic thriller *Midnight Sun*, Argentinian director **Lucía Puenzo**, cocreator of eco-thriller *Cromo*, and **Lucie Borleteau**, director of *Cannabis*.

Something for everyone

For festival-goers, it's all about watching, listening, and sharing some great experiences and Series Mania will be providing plenty of those. The festival includes **complete series screenings** of *Capital* and *Show Me a Hero*, a **marathon** of offbeat comedies, **a "work-in-progress" session** with *Marseille*, along with **a series of conferences** offering some original themes for exploration.

This year, Series Mania will be taking over two theaters in the UGC Ciné Cité Les Halles movie complex in addition to its screening rooms in the Forum des images. Most of the 50-odd series will be screened in this new location. The festival has opted to host its rock'n'roll opening night event in the legendary **Grand Rex** cinema in Paris, with a screening of the pilot of *Vinyl*, the breathtaking new series from Martin Scorsese.

Bigger and better than ever

The European TV Series Coproduction Forum, the industry arm of the Series Mania Festival, has now become a key date in the annual calendar for TV series professionals from around the world.

It runs from 19-21 April and has this year widened out its selection to include **15 TV series projects** in development. These will be presented to **300 potential co-financers**, including producers, distributors, and TV channel representatives who are expected to attend the fourth edition of the forum.

With **round tables**, **conferences** and all kinds of opportunities for **individual get-togethers**, participants will be able to explore some of the key issues facing this rapidly expanding industry. In collaboration with the CNC, the **European TV Series Conference Day** will be the highpoint of the Coproduction Forum.

David Chase, showrunner of the legendary series *The Sopranos*, will head up a prestigious jury including four other big names from the world of TV, cinema, and culture. This jury will select the best international series from the selection exclusively presented at Series Mania through two prizes: The **Grand Prix** and **Best Screenplay**.

International speakers

An audience with David Chase, creator of *The Sopranos* and jury president

David Chase was born in 1945 into an Italian-American family, like the characters in the series that made his name. Chase transformed *The Sopranos* into the quintessential series, thanks to HBO. Thought of as the "godfather" of the genre, he has inspired an entire generation of talented creators, such as Matthew Weiner and Terence Winter. David Chase does us the huge honor of looking back over his career and at the birth of a cult series.

An audience with Cuba Gooding Jr., actor in *The People v. O.J.*Simpson: American Crime Story

After the screening of American Crime Story

Cuba Gooding Jr. began his career on TV before moving into cinema where he has played a huge variety of roles. In 1997, he won an Oscar for Best Supporting Actor for his role in *Jerry Maguire*. Since then, Cuba Gooding Jr. has worked in a wide range of genres ranging from comedy (As Good As It Gets) to war films (Pearl Harbor). He will be discussing his amazing performance as O.J. Simpson in American Crime Story.

An audience with Clyde Phillips and his new project Feed the Beast After the screening of Feed the Beast

After having created one of the cult series of the 90s, *Parker Lewis Can't Lose*, Clyde Phillips demonstrated his talents as a showrunner on the series *Dexter*, about a man leading two lives – serial killer by night and police pathologist by day. The show was an international hit. Multi-award winner Clyde Phillips went on to create new projects such as *Nurse Jackie*, and was a guest at Series Mania in 2010. He returns this year to present his brand new creation, *Feed the Beast*.

An audience with Harlan Coben, writer and creator of *The Five*After the screening of *The Five*

Harlan Coben is the first writer to have received three of the major literary prizes in the United States. He is a master of the thriller genre, his work having been adapted for the big screen (*Tell No One*), and the small (*No Second Chance*). It is as a series creator that he will be in attendance at Series Mania, where he will be presenting *The Five*, in competition at the festival.

An audience with Leonardo Padura, writer and creator of *Four* Seasons in Havana

A major player in the world of noir fiction, Leonardo Padura writes detective novels that lift the veil on Cuban society and its contradictions. He is coming to Series Mania to present two episodes of *Four Seasons in Havana*, the adaptation of his "Four Seasons" cycle.

Frank Spotnitz has the second most writing credits to his name for the series *The X-Files* and was involved in writing the screenplays of the two spin-off movies. He will be coming to Series Mania to share his experiences as a creator for Amazon Studios and the series *The Man in the High Castle*, adapted from the novel by Philip K. Dick.

Leïla Bekhti, actress in *Midnight Sun*After the screening of *Midnight Sun*

In 2008, Leïla Bekhti appeared in two French thrillers, *Mesrine Part I: Killer Instinct* by Jean-François Richet, and *A Prophet* by Jacques Audiard. She was a smash hit in *All that Glitters*, a popular and critical hit that won her the César for Best Female Newcomer in 2010. Leïla Bekhti plays a young policewoman in the Nordic thriller *Midnight Sun*.

Lucía Puenzo, creator, writer and director of *Cromo*After the screening of *Cromo*

Lucía Puenzo is an Argentinian director, screenwriter, and novelist. In 2007, she made her first feature, *XXY*, which won the Grand Prix at Critics Week at the Festival de Cannes, as well as a Goya for Best Foreign Film. A member of the creative trio behind the series *Cromo*, Lucía Puenzo will be talking about how this eco-thriller came into being.

Stephen Poliakoff, creator, writer, and director of *Close to the Enemy*

British playwright, director, and screenwriter and director Stephen Poliakoff is known for his successful series *Perfect Strangers*; *Gideon's Daughter*, which won a Golden Globe; and *Dancing on the Edge*. The Coproduction Forum is the beating heart of Series Mania. Regions with a reputation for drama, such as Scandinavia and the United Kingdom, have a strong presence.
